About Empowerment for Local People Foundation (ELP)

ELP supports disadvantaged persons starting or scaling petite businesses in local communities with requisite business training, technical support and interest-free loans pooled from the public in small units.

Project Summary:

Can product-level data recording by small business owners enable them to improve their business practices and outcomes, in addition to improving the accuracy of firm data available to researchers and policymakers in low-income countries? Little is known about the behavior of small businesses in low-income countries, particularly pertaining to their practices around record-keeping. Anecdotally, business owners in these contexts have been reluctant to keep thorough records of their products due to perceived lack of benefits (in relation to large attentional, mental, and time costs) and the desire to not leave a trail for tax authorities. Yet, systematic product-level record-keeping is the standard for modern firms in developed economies. The implication of this is that most of what we know about firm behavior has come from such firms; small-scale firms in low-income economies remain a black box even though there are "vast armies" of them across the developing world. This motivates us to study how small businesses in low-income countries can be induced to keep product-level records (using an App or accounting partners) and whether they can actually, tangibly, benefit from record-keeping as it has been found to improve decision making. We propose to study the impact of more granular product-level data, as these pieces of information are more digestible and actionable for businesses, improving the likelihood that they will continue to record it.
